PE


We will be developing our Hockey skills in PE.

English

Mathematics

Add and subtract whole numbers and decimals using formal written methods and solving multistep word problems.

Perform mental calculations for the 4 operations($+-x \div$) and large numbers and decimals. Recall multiplication facts up to 12 \times 12. Compare and classify 2D and 3d shapes based on their properties and sizes.



Science

The Science for this term is Light and Sound. We will find out about how we see, how light travels, how shadows and reflections are made and how the eye works. We will find out about how sounds are made and how they travel, exam-

ining the pitch and volume.
