We will then read stories from other cultures, including, "The Librarian of Basra," and link it with our Geography.




We will also read Myths and Legends.

Mathematics


Use simple formulae.

Order and compare numbers including integers, decimals and negative numbers. Add and subtract fractions with different denominators and mixed numbers Multiply and divide proper fractions. Divide numbers up to 4 Digits by a two-digit number using short and long division. Draw and translate simple shapes and reflect them in the axes using coordinates. Use negative numbers in context ie the temperature and be able to find the mean of a set of data.



Science

The Science for this term is Evolution and inheritance. We will look at Charles Darwin's theory of evolution and consider different theories of animal adaptation and survival.





RE and PSCHE

The RE for the term is Similarities and Differences between religions. Going for Goals is the theme for this term. The children will learn about setting their own goals and how to achieve them.
