



## **English**

# **Mathematics**

Add and subtract mentally a three-digit number and ones, tens and hundreds. Solve problems involving money and measures and problems involving passage of time.

Recognise and use fractions as numbers and equivalent fractions.

Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects.

Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm), mass (kg/g), volume/capacity (l/ml) and solve problems involving all of the above, Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables and solve questions using information presented in the above.

Science

The Science for this term is Light. The
