PE


We will be going swimming weekly . The children who have been swimming will be doing PE in school.




French

Later we will be reading stories from other cultures Later we will be discussing the story "The Arrival" and thinking about what it would be like to move to a different country.




Mathematics

ICT


In ICT we will be completing Unit 5.2 We are Cryptographers.
